25-00789	Overdose	2200 Blk. W Central	Adult male overdosed inside the bathroom of a business. Narcan was administered and the male later refused treatment from EMS.
25-00791	Agg. Burglary	500 Blk. W. 2 nd	Officers were called out to a possible burglary in progress at a residence. Upon the officers' arrival, the alleged suspect was in the street. The alleged suspect refused commands from officers and retrieved a metal object that had glass on it after dropping a stick that he had in his hand upon officers' arrival. Less-lethal forced was used and the alleged suspect was taken into custody.
