25-01309	Drugs	El Dorado PD	A citizen turned in suspected methamphetamine and para that he found.
25-01310	Harassment	Animal Shelter	An unknown male caller has called the animal shelter and ACO with bizarre statements about his time in a special hospital and that he is going to kill his puppies and put them in a dumpster bin.
